	Type of Recruitment Initiative	Description of Activity
1	Participated in Career & Education Fair	On April 25, 2023, the Production Director and a Sales Account Executive attended a Career & Education Fair at the Lewistown Armory and hosted by the PA National Guard of Lewistown. Over 200 hundred students were in attendance from local area public, private and charter schools. They spoke with students & members of the community about the different job opportunities available in broadcasting and with our stations. They also conducted a live onair broadcast during the career fair to promote the event and to demonstrate how beneficial radio is to the public!
2	Hosted a Job & Career Fair	On May 25, 2023, our radio station group hosted a Job & Career Fair at our radio studio and office location. Invitations were extended to the public, local area high schools, Chamber of Commerce, Universities, other media outlets and many other groups and organizations. Job & Career Fair was attended by the stations' General Sales Manager, Office/Traffic Manager, Production Director, Marketing Coordinator, Master Control and On Air Talents. The staff spoke with students & individuals about the different job opportunities available and offered on-site interviews during the event.
3	Sales & Marketing Intern with Shippensburg University	As a result of our May 2023 Career Fair, from June 26, 2023 – August 18, 2023, a Shippensburg University student, completed a summer Academic Internship in the role of Sales & Marketing. In this role, they learned the importance of getting to know the local businesses to better serve their marketing needs and serving the community by assisting with promotional events, contests and live broadcasts.
